



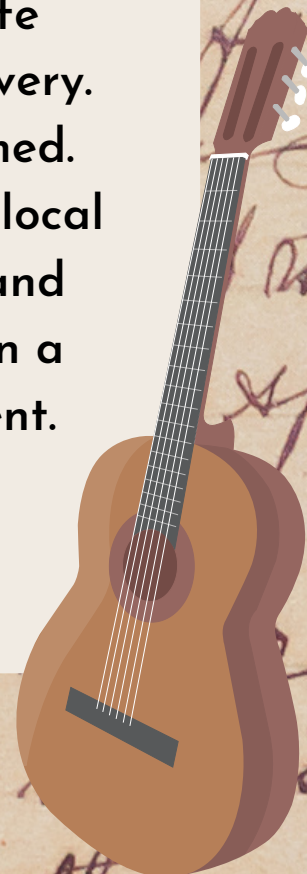
Fado Vadio

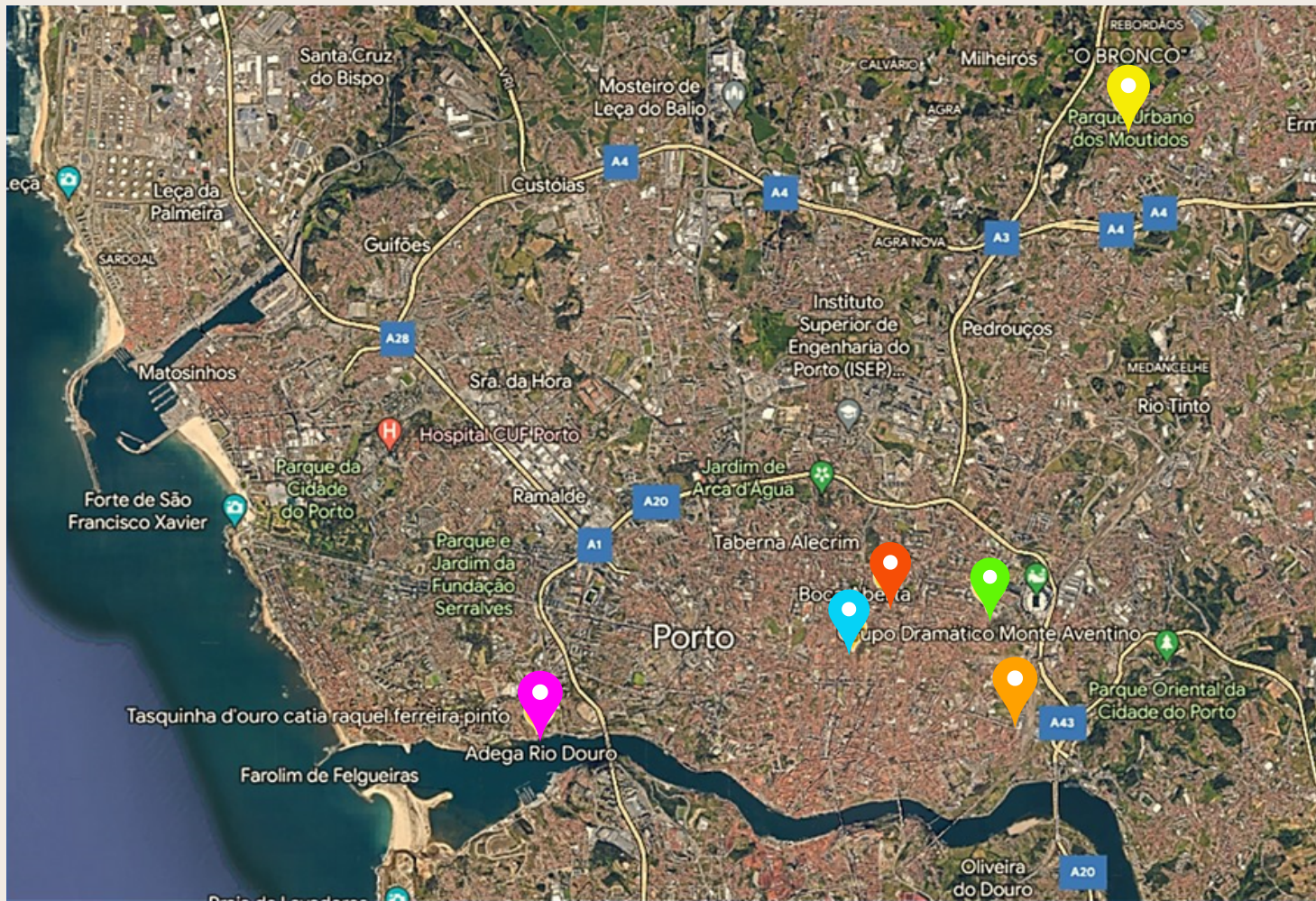
For the people, by the people



Fado vadio was born in the streets of Lisbon and represents one of the most modest expressions of intangible Portuguese cultural heritage. Improvised and non-profit, sung by everyone, even those without a gift to do so. It is the fado (song) of the people for the people, sung by fadistas and non-fado singers. Anyone can sing a poem or a life experience. What counts is the feeling and delivery. It has no proper place where it can be performed. The performances are organised in groups and local or regional collectivities; taverns, pubs, cafes and small restaurants, without great exuberance, in a simple, yet welcoming and familiar environment.
